

# **TV Remote Control Buttons & Functions**

## WT-46807, WS-55807, WS-65807

#### **SELECT SWITCH**

Pick the TV, CABLE/DBS/DTV,VCR, DVD or AUDIO layer to operate the equipment of your choice.

#### NUMBER KEYS (0-9)

Enter a channel number, or a V-Chip lock code.

#### SQV (SuperQuickView™) .

View channels you have programmed into SuperQuickView™ (SQV) memory.

#### INPUT .

Select the input source to watch:TV channels on Antenna A or Antenna B or other equipment connected to the external inputs.

#### CHANNEL CONTROL

Press the top part to change to a channel with a higher number. Press the bottom part to change to a channel with a lower number.

#### LIGHT BUTTON •

Use to illuminate select buttons on the remote control (for four seconds).

#### ENTER/EXCH

Select a channel number or menu item. Exchange PIP or POP and main TV picture.

#### CANCEL


Clear a channel programmed into SuperQuickView memory; clear the settings of some on-screen menus.

#### V-CHIP

Enable/Disable the V-Chip Lock with the convenient press of a button.

#### **ADJUST BUTTONS**

Navigate within the on-screen menus.
Adjust sound or picture. Move the Picture-in-Picture (PIP) location on the screen and select items in the menus.



#### POWER BUTTON

Turn power on or off.

#### QV (QuickView™)

Instantly switch to last channel viewed. Press again to return to original channel.

#### SLEEP

Program the TV to turn off automatically.

#### VIDEO

Select individual video settings to adjust.

#### AUDIO

Select individual audio settings to adjust.

#### VOLUME

Press the top part to increase the volume; press the bottom part to decrease.

#### MUTE

Turn off sound completely or restore it to its original volume.

#### HOME

Exit on-screen menus and return to TV viewing.

#### **MENU**

Display the on-screen TV menu system, which contains additional instructions for special functions.

#### INFO

Display on-screen summary of the current input used and any broadcast information available (including current V-Chip information).

#### **GUIDE**

Displays the on-screen program guide of some cable boxes and satellite receivers.

# PIP (PICTURE-IN-PICTURE) and POP (PICTURE-OUTSIDE-PICTURE) CONTROLS

- ADJUST After displaying PIP, press to change the image position.
- EXCH Exchange the PIP and main images.
- PIP INPUT Press repeatedly to switch the source of the PIP or POP image between the TV and external inputs.
- FORMAT Change the shape and size of the main TV picture.
- PIP/POP Display or cancel the PIP image. Display, change, or cancel
   POP.
- **PIP CH** (PIP channel key) Change the channel of the PIP image.

## AUDIO/VIDEO CONTROLS

#### VIDEC

Use the video key to select:

- IRIS™
- Contrast
- Brightness
- Sharpness
- Color
- Tint
- Color temperature (low6500K/ medium/high)
- Video Noise
- Image Type

#### **AUDIO**

Use the audio key to select:

- Bass
- Treble
- Balance
- Surround (simulate/surround/off)
- Listen to (stereo/SAP/mono)
- Level sound (on/off)


PAUSE - Freeze the PIP/POP image or return to a "live" image.

## HOW TO VIEW YOUR VCR OR OTHER EQUIPMENT

To view the signals from your VCR or other equipment you have connected, select the correct input source. Press the INPUT key on the remote control or the front panel. You can choose from the following input sources:

- ANT-A or ANT-B -- (antennas or cable systems connected to the two antenna terminals)
- **DTV** -- (Equipment connected to the DTV input on the back of your TV)
- Input I -- is used for Home Theater. Refer to your TV Owner's Guide for additional details
- Input I/Input 2/Input 3 -- (equipment connected to the terminals on the back of your TV)
- Input 4 -- (equipment connected to the terminals on the front panel of your TV)
- Component-I/Component-2--(equipment connected to the component inputs on the back of your TV)


